Hackney Pensions Board – would you like to be involved in the running of the London Borough of Hackney Pension Fund as a Scheme Member Representative on the Pensions Board?

The Hackney Pensions Board is an advisory board that works alongside the Hackney Pensions Committee to assist the Council in ensuring that the Local Government Pension Scheme (LGPS) is managed efficiently and effectively.

The LBH Pension Fund is part of the LGPS and is responsible for administering the current and future benefits of circa 25,000 members, of whom around 7,000 are still contributing with over 40 different employers.

The Pensions Committee has responsibility for the management of the Pension Fund and for the strategic and investment decisions of the Fund. The Pensions Board assists the Council in ensuring that the Fund complies with regulations and is run as efficiently as possible.

The Pensions Board comprises 2 scheme member representatives and 2 employer representatives. We are currently looking for 2 Member Representatives who would be

interested in joining the Board to represent the interests of all members of the scheme. As a member of the Pensions Board, you will help to ensure the London Borough of Hackney Pension Fund is managed and administered in accordance with the Code of Practice on governance and administration of public sector pensions schemes issued by the Pensions Regulator (tPR).

For the **Scheme Member Representative role**, we are looking for an enthusiastic individual with an interest in pensions and the capacity to represent the interest of all scheme members. You must be an active, deferred or pensioner member of the Local Government Pension Scheme, although you need not be a member of the Hackney Fund.

Training for the roles will be provided, but you must be able to understand complex financial and legal information and act impartially. Good communication skills are also essential, as is time to attend meetings and training sessions.
